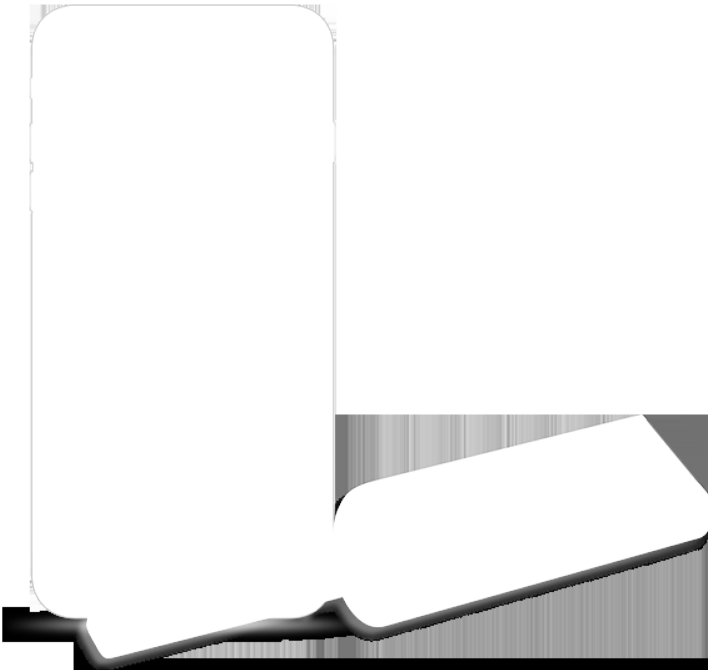


Med Tech startup launches fertility monitor
