

Vizag to get a cancer research park

A world-class cancer research park is soon to be developed in Visakhapatnam. A high-level team from America-based Elixys and noted companies in cancer care will be visiting the city to explore the project further.

Named Vyas Cancer Park (VCR), it is aimed at making the park a prominent hub for cancer research. The aim of the project is to create a comprehensive life science ecosystem that specialises in bringing together various stakeholders from around the world to undertake research in the VCR Park.
