

E-pharmacy Myra raises \$1.84M from Tokyo firm

Bengaluru-based Metarain Software Solutions Pvt. Ltd, which runs online pharmacy app Myra, has raised about Rs 12 crore (\$1.84 million) in a fresh round.

Tokyo-headquartered management consulting firm Dream Incubator led the round with an infusion of Rs 6.5 crore (\$1 million), while existing investors Matrix Partners and Times Internet accounted for the rest.
