

NHA signs MoU for Ayushman Bharat implementation

National Health Agency (NHA), the apex body for the implementation of Ayushman Bharat-National Health Protection Mission (AB-NHPM) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to provide information and eligibility validation services to beneficiaries, especially in remote areas.

As the benefits under AB-NHPM are based on entitlement and not on enrolment, over 3 lakh Common Service Centres (CSCs) spread across the rural India can become the key point of information for potential beneficiaries and help in validating their entitlement.
