Top 5 Startups:

- **Caredose** (Kinshuk Kocher) – Tracks the medicine doses & helps in taking the medicine at the right time
- **Spectral Insights** (Nishant Jain) – A compact scanner
- **Dozee** (Pritish Gupta) – Monitors the sleep, heartbeat, respiration and notification on mobile
- **Aura – Ekistics Solutions** (Dr. Srikant Mohapatra) - Breakthrough medical technology designed by Ekistics, offers replacement and reconstruction of damaged and diseased valves avoiding artificial prostheses
- **Azooka Life Sciences** (Alex D Paul, Dr Fathima) – Helps in staining DNA with the help of a plant based dye that can be conveniently used during life sciences research
