- The BIPP funding from Department of Biotechnology has strengthened the joint project between Nirmal seeds and TERI to develop hybrid varieties of mustard by using marker assisted selection technology.
- The joint efforts of Krishidhan Seeds and Jawaharlal Nehru University to create transgenic Okra free from yellow vein mosaic virus has found support from SBIRI scheme of Department of Biotechnology.
- Bejo Sheetal Seeds is closely working with ICGEB to develop hybrid varieties of stress tolerant onion. The project is supported by BIPP.
