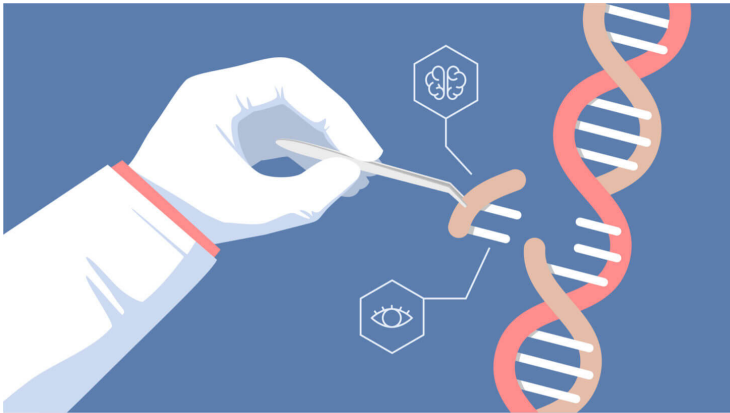


Merck strengthens CRISPR/Cas9 strategic alliance with GenOway
