The GCPP (BT) is largely delivered online allowing students to participate and learn from anywhere and while working in fulltime positions.

The course consists of weekly online webinars (typically held on Saturdays) spanning 12 weeks and two contact workshops (currently being conducted online, in view of the COVID-19 outbreak and containment measures).
