Ujala Cygnus Kulwanti Hospital has already started operations of general specialties and has plan to invest further to build 40 more beds in existing set up of facility by the next financial year in order to meet the medical needs of underserved population in Kanpur. Key clinical programmes include general surgery, orthopaedics, paediatrics, gynaecology, IVF, internal medicine, ENT to name a few. The hospital will provide a 24*7 Emergency and Trauma Centre, ICU and NICU facilities as well as advanced Radiology and Pathology services.

Our hospitals in Delhi, Haryana and Himachal Pradesh have been instrumental in filling a major void of tertiary care in these areas,” said Probal Ghosal, Chairman, Board of Directors, Ujala Cygnus Group of Hospitals.
