


CEPI picks THSTI lab for COVID-19 vaccine assays

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The lab will be inaugurated virtually by Dr Harsh Vardhan on 6th January, 2021



The Bioassay Laboratory (BL) at the Translational Health Science and Technology Institute (THSTI), an autonomous institute of the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), located in Faridabad, is a NABL-accredited lab (ISO 17025:2017) which has been selected as one of the centralized network lab for COVID-19 vaccine assays by Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations (CEPI).

BL is the first and only lab in a DBT institute with this recognition. The lab will be inaugurated virtually by Dr Harsh Vardhan, Union Minister for Science & Technology, Earth Sciences and Health & Family Welfare on 6th January, 2021.

Dr Renu Swarup, Secretary of The Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India said: "The Department of Biotechnology, Government of India is supporting efforts for COVID 19 vaccine development and testing.
