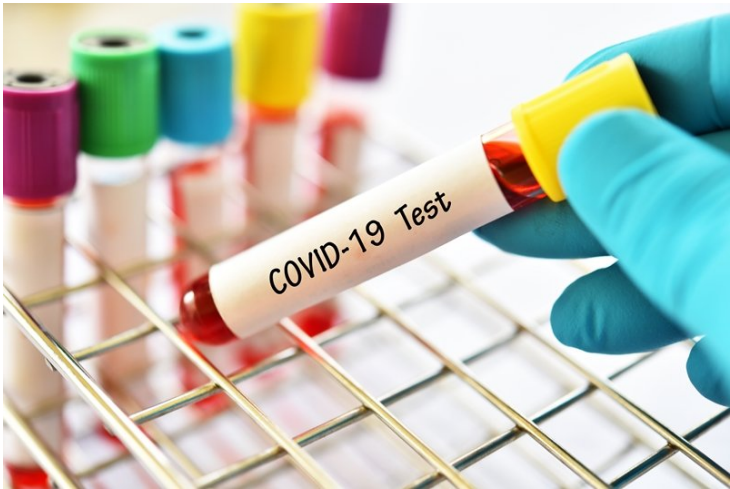


SpiceHealth launches RT-PCR tests at Rs 499
