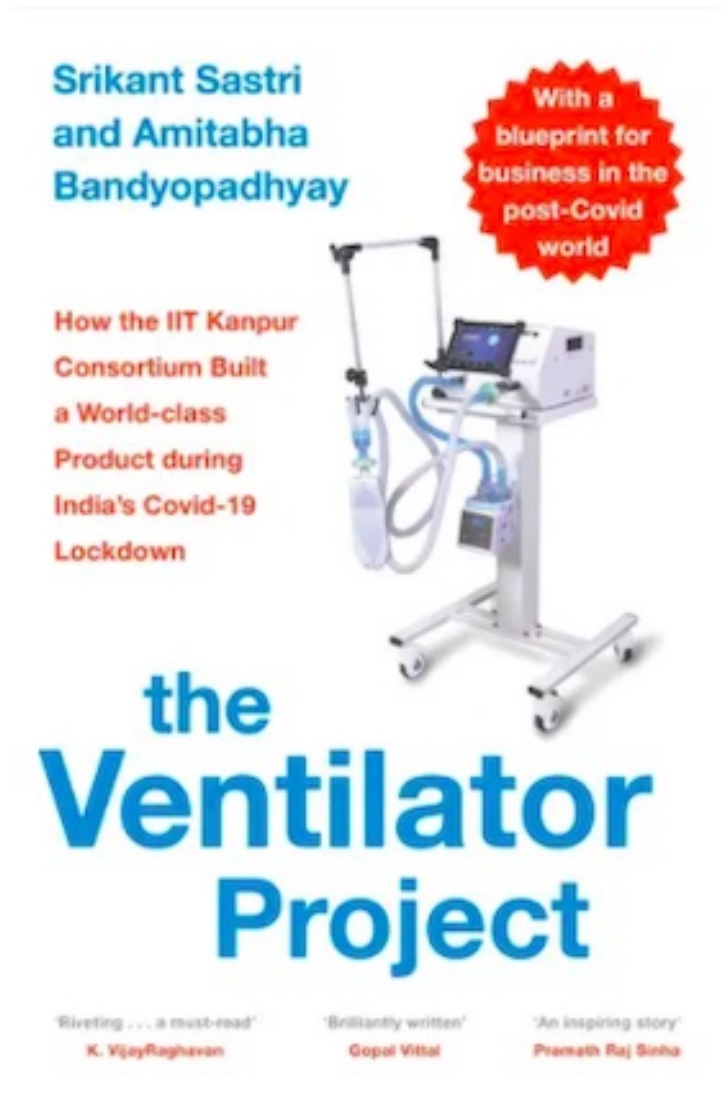


IIT Kanpur launches inspirational book ‘The Ventilator Project’
