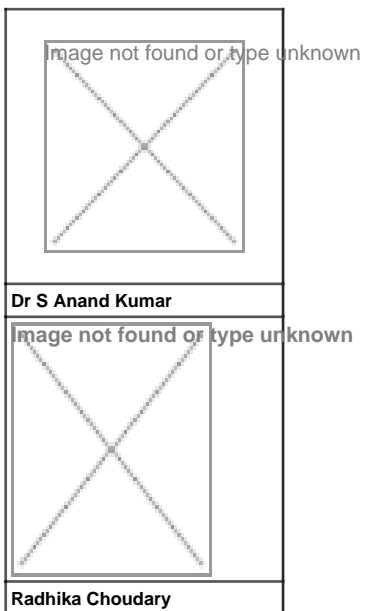
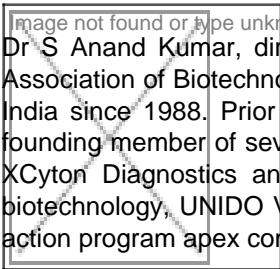


Anand Kumar, Radhika join ABLE team
