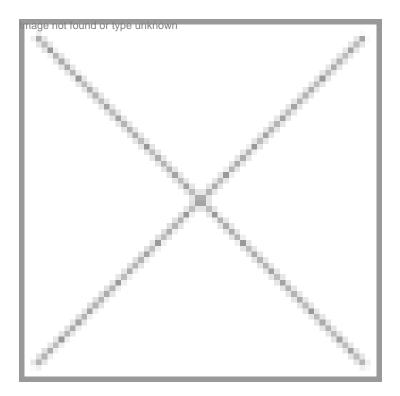



Five Padma Awards go to life sciences
