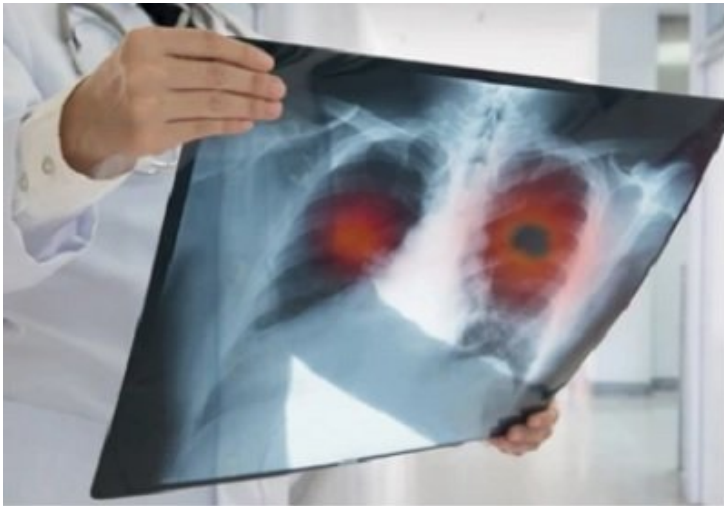


Fortis Escorts Faridabad introduces Cryo tech for lung cancer treatment

This is one of the safest procedures for tumour debulking."
