


Neoretina Eyecare Institute opens diabetics eye care facility in Hyd

The facility will offer 2-minute retina screening technology



Neoretina Eyecare Institute, a pioneer in diabetic retinopathy day-care, and super speciality facility for diabetics' eye care in Hyderabad announced the launch of its new smart '2-minute' retina check-up initiative, the first-of-its-kind, in the state of Telangana, a totally dilation free service, easing the pain of waiting for hours in clinics.

The institute also opened IRIS, a new 4000 square foot eye diagnostics laboratory adjacent to its existing 8000 square foot facility. A state-of-the-art ophthalmic diagnostic centre, optical, pharmacy, and a premium private ward for patients are all located in the IRIS block.
