It also houses an advanced Emergency and Trauma Command System that seamlessly integrates MRI, CT, and Heart/Stroke Command units with cutting-edge CATH and DSA labs, enabling swift, coordinated, and life-saving emergency care.

The Institution's Centres of Excellence cover critical disciplines including Cancer Care, Cardiac Sciences, Neurosciences, Organ Transplant, Gastroenterology, Respiratory Medicine, Urology, Nephrology, Orthopedics, and more. Additionally, each department is supported by medical teams comprising doctors from esteemed institutions such as AIIMS, along with highly skilled nursing staff from leading institutions across the country.
