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HAI Conclave 2026 calls for responsible adoption of AI across India's healthcare ecosystem

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More than 800 participants, new collaborations and a growing Health AI ecosystem mark the conclusion of the two-day conclave



HAI Conclave 2026, held on 10 and 11 July 2026 in Bengaluru, concluded with more than 800 participants, new collaborations between healthcare providers, AI innovators and startups, and a shared call for responsible adoption of Artificial Intelligence across India's healthcare ecosystem.

Hosted by Global Healthcare Academy (GHA), the two-day conclave brought together clinicians, researchers, healthcare leaders, policymakers, technology companies, startups and investors to explore how Artificial Intelligence is moving from innovation to real-world healthcare applications while keeping patient outcomes and clinical expertise at the centre.

A major highlight was The Pitch Dock, the dedicated Health AI startup pavilion that enabled startups to connect directly with hospital leaders, investors, technology partners and decision-makers. The platform accelerated conversations around adoption, partnerships and future investment while creating opportunities for real-world implementation of emerging healthcare solutions.

Adding to the conclave's key milestones, the Global Surgical Institute (GSI), part of the Global Healthcare Academy ecosystem, unveiled ALEX, an AI-powered Patient Communication Simulator. Designed to strengthen clinical reasoning, communication and decision-making through immersive simulation, the launch reflects GHA's continued commitment to advancing AI-enabled healthcare education and preparing future-ready healthcare professionals.

The conclave also featured a dedicated roundtable with Vice Chancellors from across different states, focusing on the role of Artificial Intelligence in strengthening India's education ecosystem. The discussion explored opportunities to integrate AI into healthcare education, build future-ready professionals and create responsible frameworks to prepare the next generation of healthcare leaders.

Dr B. S. Ajaikumar, Executive Chairman, Global Healthcare Academy, said, "What we witnessed over the past two days was not simply interest in Artificial Intelligence, but genuine collaboration between healthcare and technology.
