Govt to soon set up university of medicine



Modi government will set up a University of Medicines, which will provide a place of pride to all schools of medicines including allopathic and traditional.

The union health minister, Mr J P Nadda has stated that the university will be a repository of knowledge on communicable and non-communicable diseases and help broaden understanding towards traditional medicines and its benefits.

He was addressing the 'Stop Diabetes Movement (SDM) All India Review meeting', organised by S-Vyasa University, Bangalore on July 13, 2015.

"This university will carry out documentation of diseases and their treatment and cure through various traditional practices," Nadda said.

"The University of Medicines will be a repository of all knowledge on communicable and non-communicable diseases and help us to broaden our understanding towards traditional medicines and its benefits," he said.

Mr Nadda said that the prevalence of lifestyle related non-communicable diseases such as hypertension, diabetes and others were on the "rise" in India and it has added to the burden of already existing communicable disease.
