Indian Pharmexcil recently announced awards for outstanding export performances in the bulk drugs and formulations category, for the year 2013-14. Of the 150 applications, Lupin, Aurobindo and Mylan bagged top awards for their exceptional performance.

Mumbai-based Lupin received the 'all-round performer' award, while Aurobindo Pharma and Mylan Laboratories have been judged as leading bulk drugs and formulations exporters respectively.
