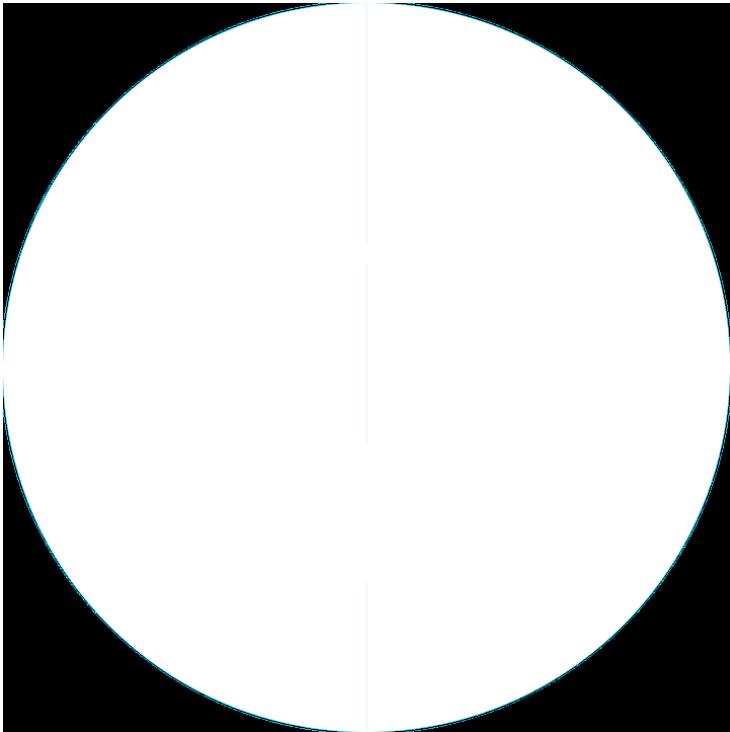


Dr. Meshram honored for contribution to neurology

Dr Meshram is the first doctor from the country nominated for Tropical Neurology group of World Federation of Neurology (WFN).

Recently, he brought Nagpur on the international map for the first time by organizing Orange City International Film Festival in the city.
